

Advanced Certificate in **COUPLE & FAMILY SYSTEMS THERAPY** **2027 FEE STRUCTURE**



The *Advanced Certificate in Couple and Family Systems Therapy* is structured with a two-year core program plus additional program elements which can be completed alongside the program enrolment period or up to 8 years beforehand as part of the Recognised Prior Learning (RPL) pathway. RPL activities include the Family of Origin Research Program groups, Clinical Supervision Groups, the Parent Hope Project training and Workshops. Payments can be made in full per year / group enrolment, or with a quarterly payment instalment plan.
